

## HUNT 08-104



Set in the heart of Africa, Zambia is one of the premiere hunting destinations today. The fine climate, excellent people and abundance of wildlife make it a part of Africa not to miss. Zambia is also home to some unique species like Kafue lechwe, Lichtenstein's hartebeest and Crawshay's Defassa waterbuck, to name a few. The hunting is on 13,000 acres of privately owned property which is in the southern province, approximately 95 miles from Victoria Falls and about that same distance from Lake Kariba - for those wanting to do some tiger fishing. The vegetation in the hunting area is Miombo Woodland interspersed with large valleys of grassland. The larger trees and termite mounds found throughout the area, coupled with the long grass, make it conducive for stalking. Some water hole hunting from blinds is also available.
